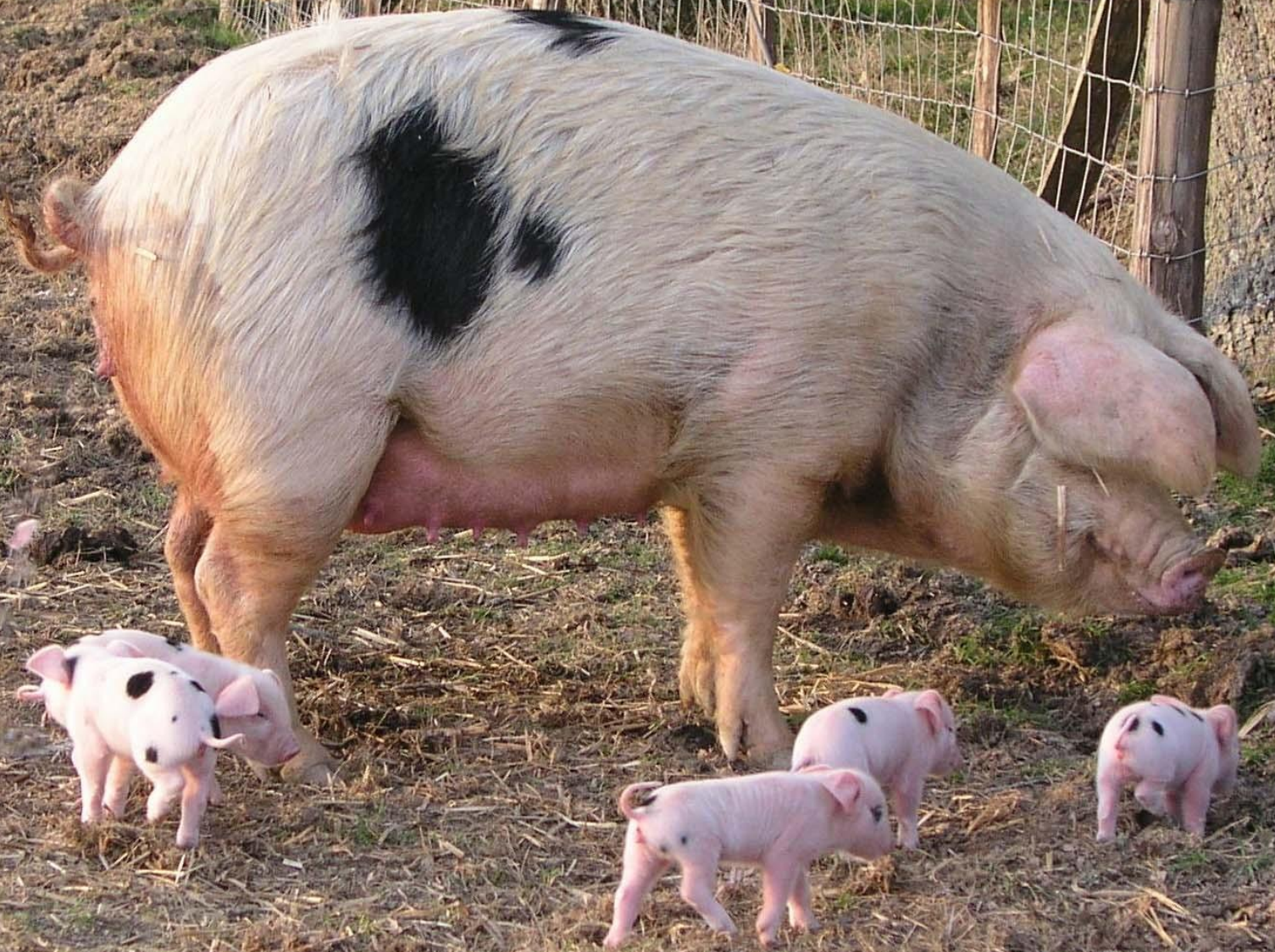


Organic food at sensible prices

**Cuckoo's Pit Farm
Woodchurch, Kent**



***Producers of beef, lamb, pork,
poultry, eggs, sausages,
and vegetables in season***

- Our animals are reared naturally in family groups and eat only grass. In winter, feed for cattle and sheep is home grown hay and silage.
- We use **no** artificial fertilisers, pesticides or weed killers.
- Animal welfare is of prime importance to us. We use no additives or growth promoters and there is no routine use of antibiotics, but we work with our vets to continuously monitor our animals health



- We specialise mostly in traditional breeds
- This is local food with low food miles and full traceability from pasture to plate
- ***Our aim is to produce organic food at prices which compete with non-organic supermarket food***

Cattle

We maintain two suckler herds of cattle, where calves stay with their mothers until naturally weaned: White Park cattle, the oldest breed of cattle in the UK, and Blonde d'Aquitaine, a large, continental breed, developed specifically to produce the finest quality beef.

We hang all of our beef for 28 days to allow flavour to develop and to ensure tenderness.



Sheep

We keep traditional breeds of sheep including Welsh Lley, Southdown and Wiltshire Horn, all well known for producing excellent lamb. They live their whole lives outside on grass



Pigs



Gloucester Old Spots and Berkshires forage freely in a ten acre oak bluebell wood. Additionally they are fed on organic concentrates which have no nasty additives and definitely no Genetically Modified ingredients. They lead an idyllic existence and produce the most delicious pork and sausages

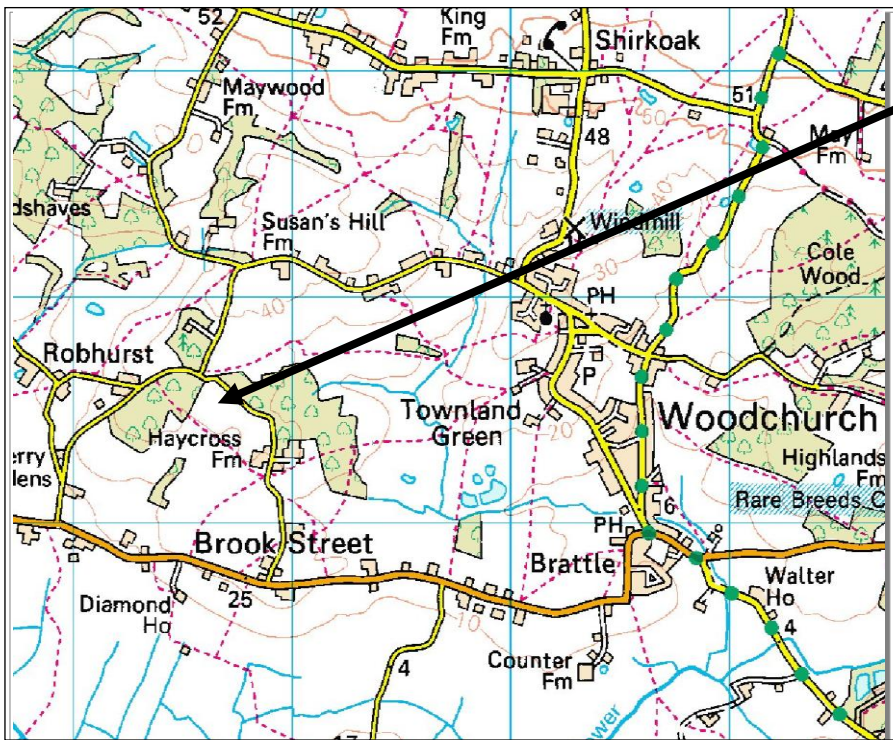
Chickens, Guinea Fowl, Turkeys

Chickens, Guinea Fowl and Turkeys are reared to soil association organic standards. To produce a high quality table bird.



Directions

From Tenterden take the B2067 towards Woodchurch. Pass the Tenterden Golf Club on the left and after about one mile, turn left into an unmarked lane. (**Look for the sign of the pointing pink pig**). Fork right at 200yds. and after about three quarters of a mile fork right again by the grass triangle. Cuckoo's Pit Farm is on the right. From Woodchurch, drive down Susan's Hill and after about three quarters of a mile fork left by the second grass triangle. **The farm shop is open every day but this is a working farm and sometimes we are away from the shop. Please ring the bell, or telephone first to make sure we are there to serve you.**
